BULLES DE MUSCAT - 0.0% VOL.

Because sobriety doesn't mean giving up fine bubbles, Jaillance highlights **Bulles de Muscat**, its 100% alcohol-free cuvée, made from French grapes grown by its vinegrowers. Inspired by the iconic Clairette de Die recipe, it is made from the Muscat Blanc à Petits Grains grape. With no artificial flavors added, it reveals a fruity and naturally aromatic profile, true to Jaillance's savoir-faire.

Tasting notes: peach, apricot, lychee, and rose.

With 8% vol., the AOC Clairette de Die Doux perfectly illustrates the "low-alcohol" trend. Its unique fermentation process follows the ancestral "méthode dioise", stopping the yeast with the action of cold. With no added sugar, it naturally delights with its fruity sweetness, made exclusively from Muscat Blanc à Petits Grains grapes from the Diois region.

Tasting notes: peach, apricot, lychee, and rose.

Why invite it to your table?

- A lower alcohol content than most wines in its category (8% vol.).
- A natural composition with no added sugar thanks to its unique ancestral method.
- Its already aromatic profile is perfect for a simple and economical tasting: serve in a nice glass with ice cubes and a slice of lime for the perfect pairing.

The Clairette de Die range has just been awarded "Flavor of the Year 2026" by a panel of French consumers, with scores above 16/20.
